**Subject:** **Reminder regarding the 2 knot current limit at Stanovan and Canexus**

**Geographic Area:** Vancouver Harbour

**Details:** There is a 2 knot current berthing limit in effect at these two terminals. This has never been an issue in the past due to the 2 knot MRA current restriction. Recently however due to vessels moving from anchor to these two berths this has been ignored and thus this notice is to serve as a reminder that this limitation is still in effect.

**Guideline:** **For vessels berthing and unberthing at Stanovan Terminal and Canexus Chemicals Canada the maximum allowable current is 2-knots.**
