- Subject:** COVID-19 Notice #4, Pre-arrival Information
- Geographic Area:** Compulsory Pilotage Waters of British Columbia including the Fraser River
- Communication:** In addition to all pre-arrival ship notices, the PPA requires that vessels' masters (or agents) confirm the health status of all persons onboard prior to embarking a pilot.
- Application:** This notice applies to all vessels that intend to employ the services of a marine pilot for inbound, outbound and shifting assignments. This notice will be in effect until the Public Health Agency of Canada declares that COVID-19 is no longer a concern. Additional measures may follow depending on the evolution of the pandemic situation.
