

OWNER/OPERATOR WAIVER COMPLIANCE

ANNUAL WAIVER RENEWALS / NEW WAIVER APPLICATIONS



The undersigned authorised representative of our company hereby confirms the following:

1. Compliance with *General Pilotage Regulations*

For the duration of the waiver year, our company will ensure that all our deck watch officers have the appropriate certificate of competency, as defined by the [General Pilotage Regulations](#), and the required number of voyages in the Area for which the waiver is being sought as per the [Interim Order Respecting Waivers of Compulsory Pilotage Granted by the Pacific Pilotage Authority](#), prior to sailing in British Columbia compulsory pilotage waters.

Please review and initial:

- a) Our deck watch officers hold the Certificate(s) of Competency that are required by Part 2 of the [Marine Personnel Regulations](#) or, if the ship is not Canadian, equivalent certificates (i.e. appropriate for the vessel).
- b) Our deck watch officers comply with the return voyage requirements associated with the Area for which the waiver is being sought as per the [Interim Order](#).
- c) Operating under a waiver does not exempt the operator from complying with the [Canada Shipping Act](#) and its associated regulations.

The PPA may verify compliance with the terms of the waiver through periodic audits of voyage and/or vessel records.

2. Contravention

Our organization understands that vessels (or combination of vessels) failing to meet the requirements for pilotage waivers under the *General Pilotage Regulations* or Interim Order are subject to pilotage fees under Section 44 of the [Pilotage Act](#). Any contravention of the waiver requirements may result in suspension or revocation of our pilotage waiver and/or monetary fines.
